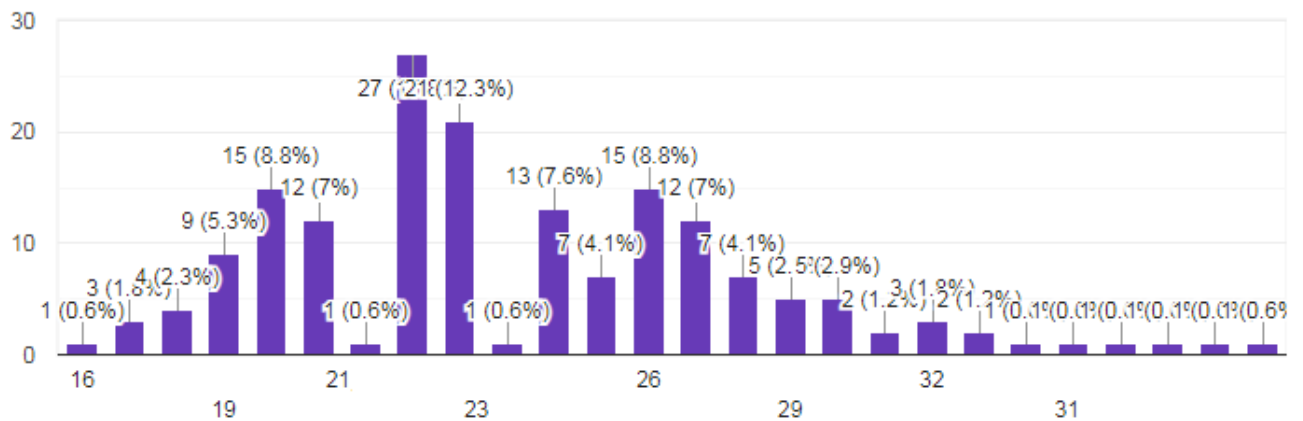
Student Satisfaction Survey for A.Y. 2018-19

Following are the statistics of the survey.

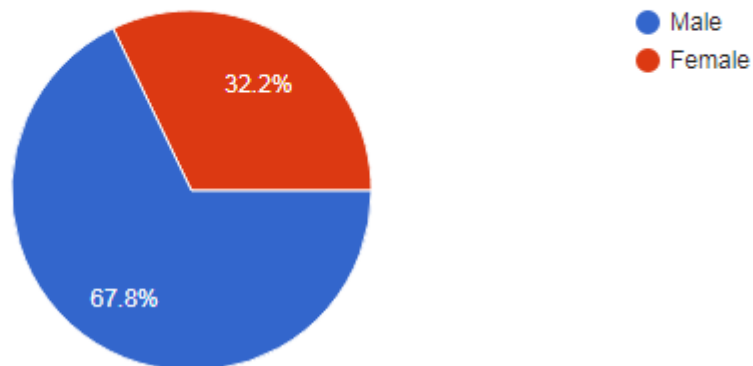
A. Age

171 responses



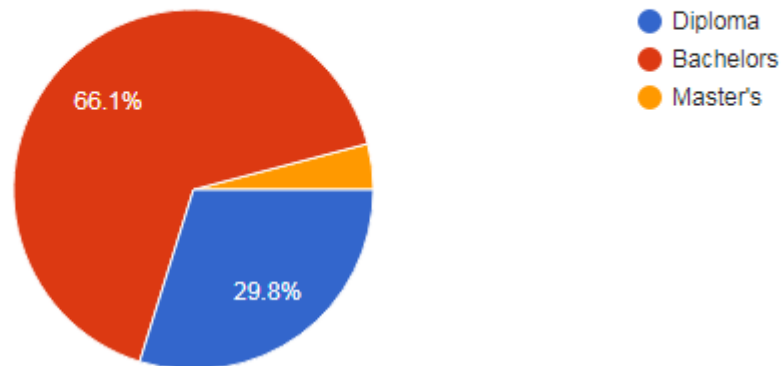
B. Gender

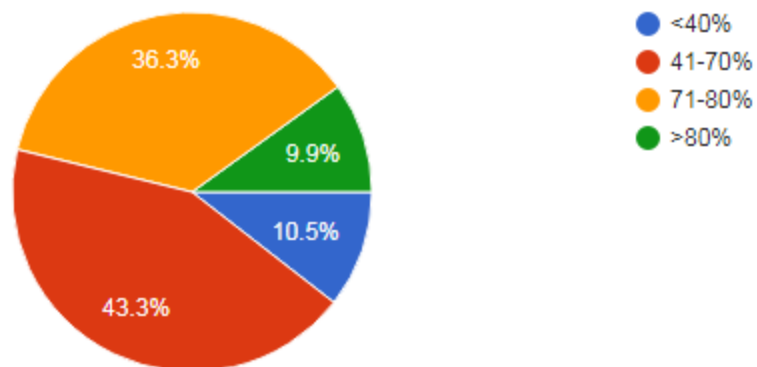
C. What degree program are you pursuing now?

171 responses

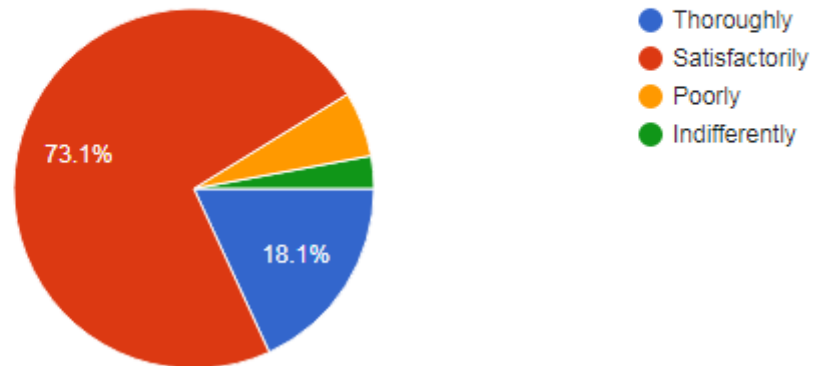


Observations:

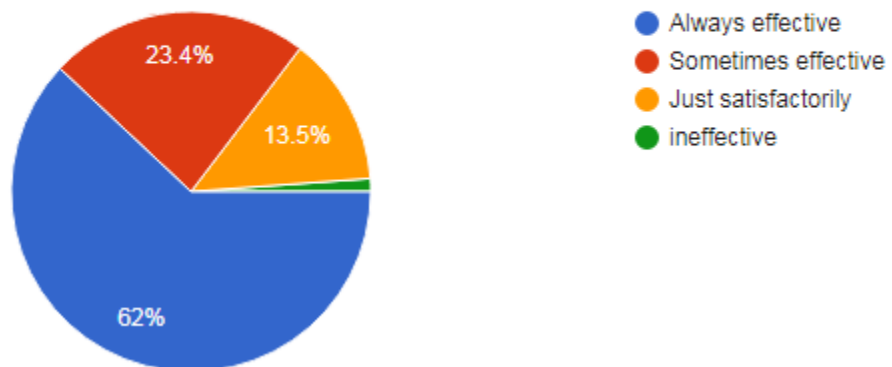


Observations:

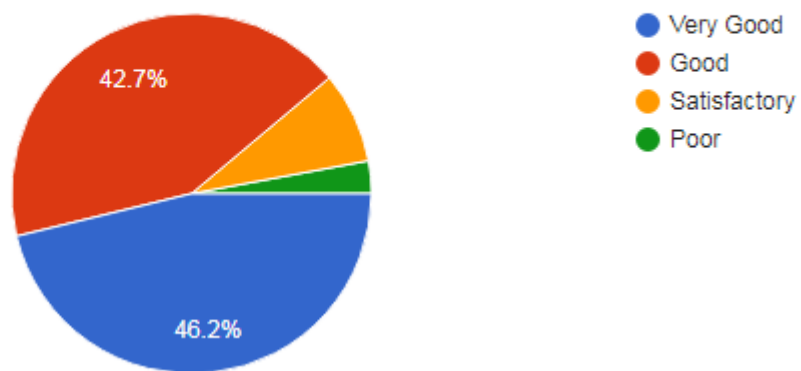


Observations:

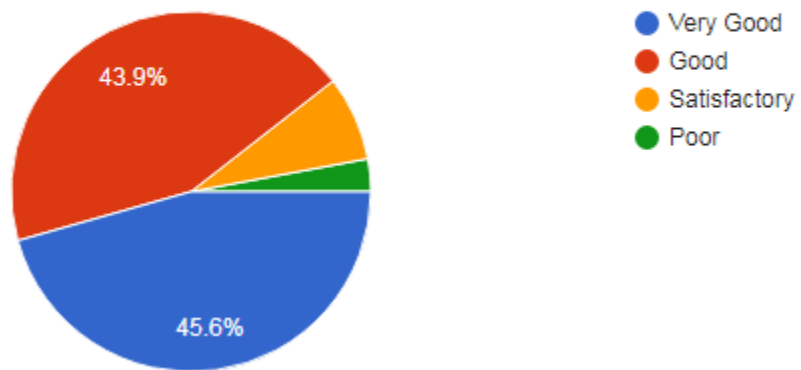


Observations:

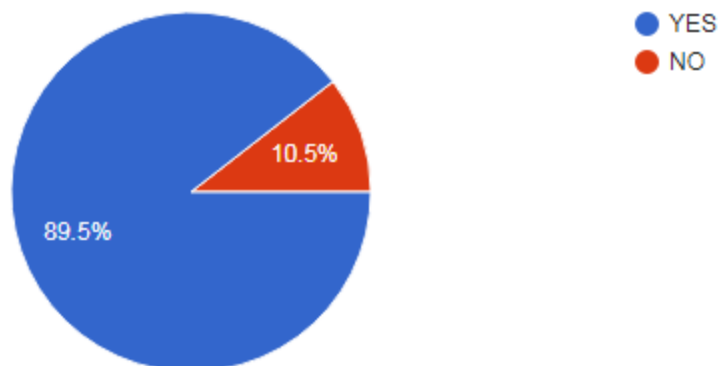


Observation:

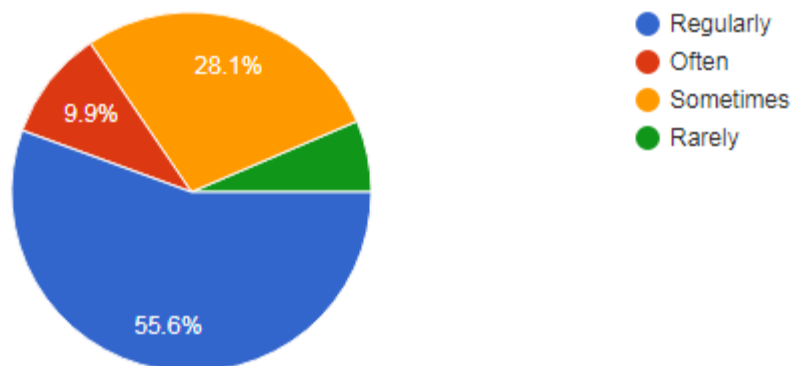


Observation:

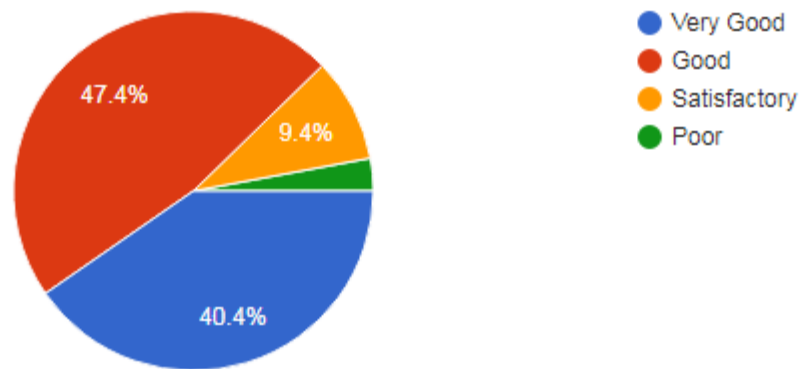


Observation:

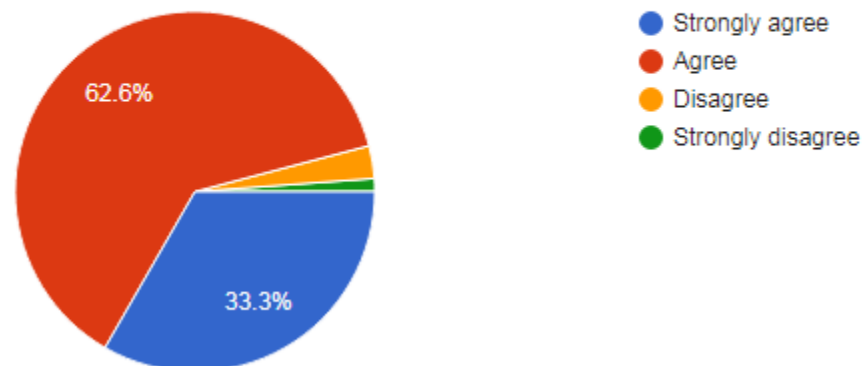

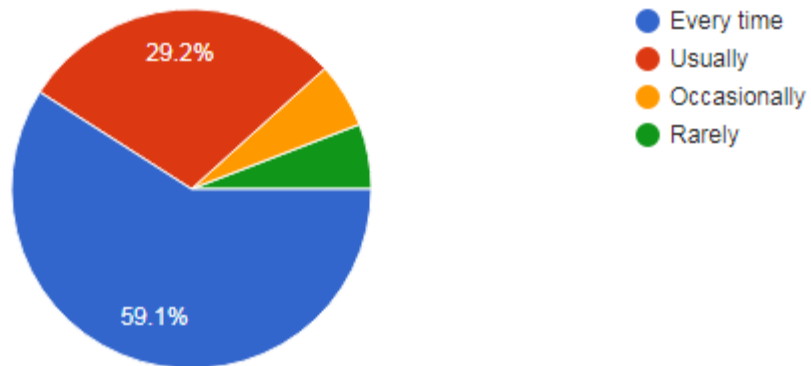

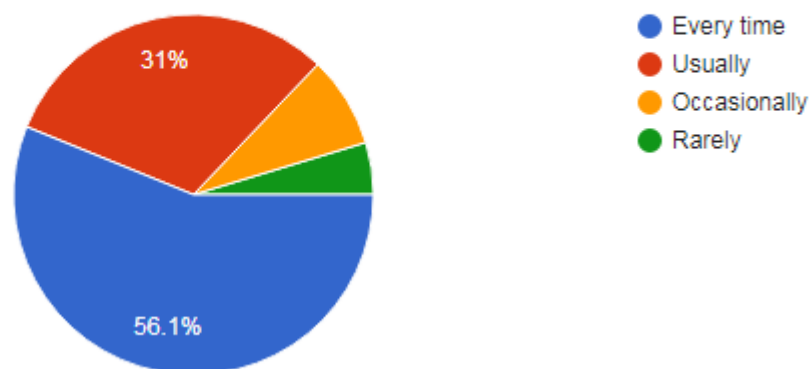


Observation:

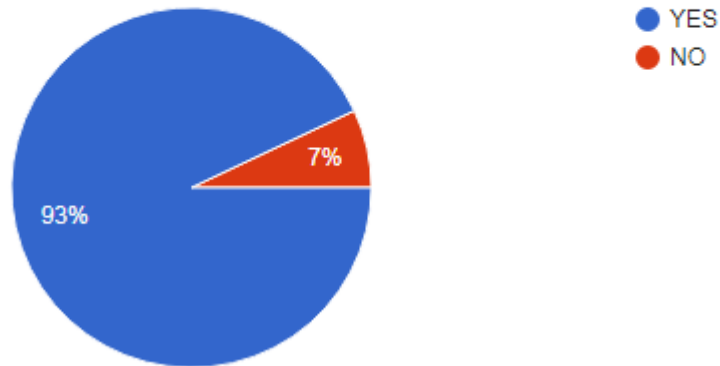


Observation:

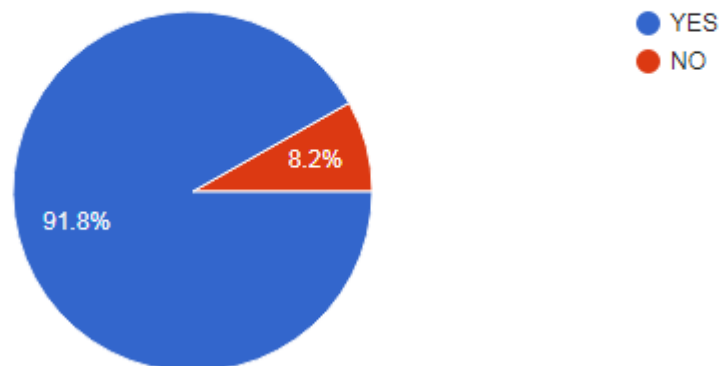


Observation:

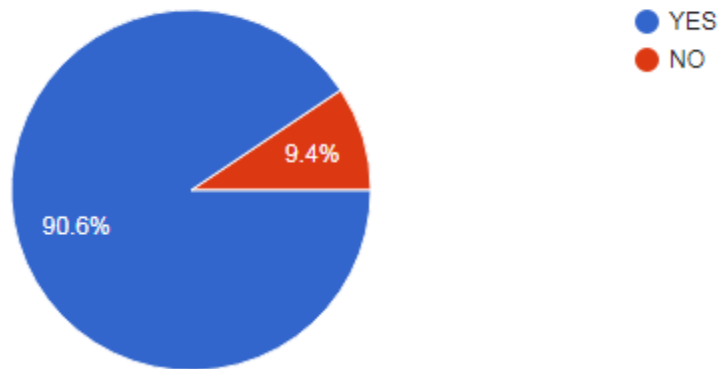


Observation:

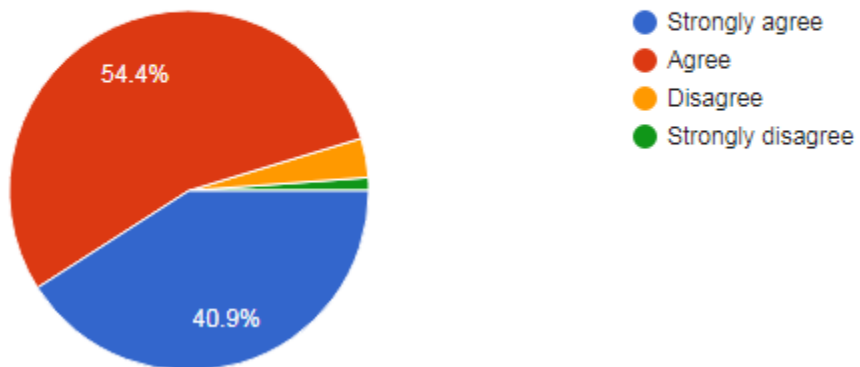


Observation:
